
- discussing client needs, analysing skin characteristics and advising on suitable skin care, treatments and application of make-up

Everything outside the 18 Industry Categories are classified as "Other Services". Personal Care Services The Personal Care industry covers work focusing on supporting people's health, well-being and beauty. If you are interested in working with people on a very personal level, are a good communicator and want to

People in this industry typically work in a salon environment but may also work in resorts, day spas, cruise ships, or hotels.
